#### 1. Location and access

**Sweden** is a Nordic country on the Scandinavian Peninsula in Northern Europe. Sweden has borders with Norway to the west and Finland to the northeast and it is connected to Denmark by the Öresund Bridge in the south.

At 450,295 km<sup>2</sup>, Sweden is the third largest country in the European Union in terms of area, and it has a total population of about 9.2 million. Sweden has a low population density of 21 inhabitants per square kilometre, but with a considerably higher density in the southern half of the country. Sweden's capital is Stockholm, which is also the largest city in the country (population of 1.3 million in the urban area and with 2 million in the metropolitan area). The second and third largest cities are Gothenburg and Malmö.

The official language is Swedish. Swedish national currency is the Swedish krona (SEK), 1 krona = 100 öre, 1 EURO  $\sim$  10 SEK. To make a call to Sweden, please dial the national telephone code +46 and then the phone number (usually without the leading zero).



**Borlänge** is a municipality in Dalarna County, central Sweden, 200 km northwest of Stockholm, with an area of 586.4 km<sup>2</sup>. The municipality has a population of 47,640 (2007). The University of Dalarna is situated in the twin cities of Borlänge and Falun. The number of students is 2500.

# **10.** Participation

WUOC2010 Participants

- Have to be students who are currently officially registered as proceeding towards a degree or diploma at a university or similar institute whose status is recognized by the appropriate national academic authority of their country, or former students who have obtained their academic degree or diploma in the year 2009;
- Must be at least 17 and less than 28 years of age on January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010 (date of birth must be between January 1<sup>st</sup>, 1982 and December 31<sup>st</sup>, 1992);
- Must have full passport-holding citizenship of the country they represent.

Each country may enter a team with a maximum of 12 competitors (6 woman and 6 men) and 5 team officials. The maximum number of competitors from each country who may participate in each race is:

Sprint: Long distance: Middle distance: Relay: 3 men and 3 women 4 men and 4 women 4 men and 4 women 2 men's teams (3 legs) 2 women's teams (3 legs)



#### 16. Punching system and timing

WUOC will use the SPORTident punching system on all events.

It is allowed to use your own SPORTident (only version 5 & 6 is allowed). The entry fee will cover the rental of SPORTident cards.

For those using their own SPORTident card, the SPORTident card number should be reported to the organizer at the same time as the nominative entry. This should be 19<sup>th</sup> June at the latest.

The competitor must use the same SI card for all the races.

Competitors are reminded if the IOF rules that says:

- It is the competitors responsibility to ensure correct punching
- If a SPORTident station fails to operate then the competitor must use the backup pin punch to make a mark in the reserve box provided on the map and report this at the finish.

SPORTident will not be used for official timekeeping, but will be used for split time presentation. Unofficial split times recorded by SPORTident will be published.

An independent backup timing system will be used throughout the competition.

### 17. Clothing

In accordance with Swedish Orienteering Federation rules, the runners should wear clothing **covering the whole body** except for head, neck and arms. Shoulders and knees must be covered. This does not apply to the sprint competition. There are no restrictions

#### 18. Weather

The weather in Borlänge in July is normally nice and warm during the day and mild at night. Average daily temperatures this month range from 18 - 25 degrees Celsius. There is approximately 2-3 hours of darkness during the nights.

#### 19. Travel information

Borlänge is situated about 130 km north of Stockholm/Västerås Airport (served by Ryan Air); 200 km north-west of Stockholm/Arlanda Airport (2 hours by train). From Stockholm/ Skavsta airport (served by Ryan Air and Wizz Air), the distance to Borlänge is about 270 km (there are no direct connections by train or bus from Stockholm Skavsta to Borlänge).

The organizers will arrange one complimentary transport from Stockholm/Arlanda to Borlänge. This transport will be sometime during Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> July, depending on travel plans for the arriving teams. Exact time will be communicated after the 19<sup>th</sup> June.

The organizers will arrange one complimentary transport from Borlänge to Stockholm/Arlanda on Saturday morning 24<sup>th</sup> July.

The organizers can, if there enough persons who are interested, arrange transportation to O-Ringen in Örebro 2010, the 5-days competition. There will be an extra fee for that transportation.

"Doping is fundamentally contrary to the spirit of sport" - Doping is strictly prohibited.

The organizers of WUOC2010 are committed to do everything required to support the official anti-doping authorities in the successful and transparent realization of their work. We strongly support all positive efforts to keep our sport clean and free of doping. IOF Anti-Doping Code and its rules, valid from 1st June 2009, shall be in force during WUOC2010.

The doping tests will be conducted in accordance with the procedures laid down in WADA International Standard for Testing and the FISU Medical Regulation, valid form July 2007. A doping control may be carried out at any time during the competition period. All communication with the Organizers about doping control issues should be done through the WUOC Office.

#### 23. Medical services

Emergency medical services are available at the event arenas for all races. For other medical problems we will refer you to the local hospital and medical centres in Borlänge. The organizer can assist in arranging healthcare services for participants in WUOC2010 if required.
